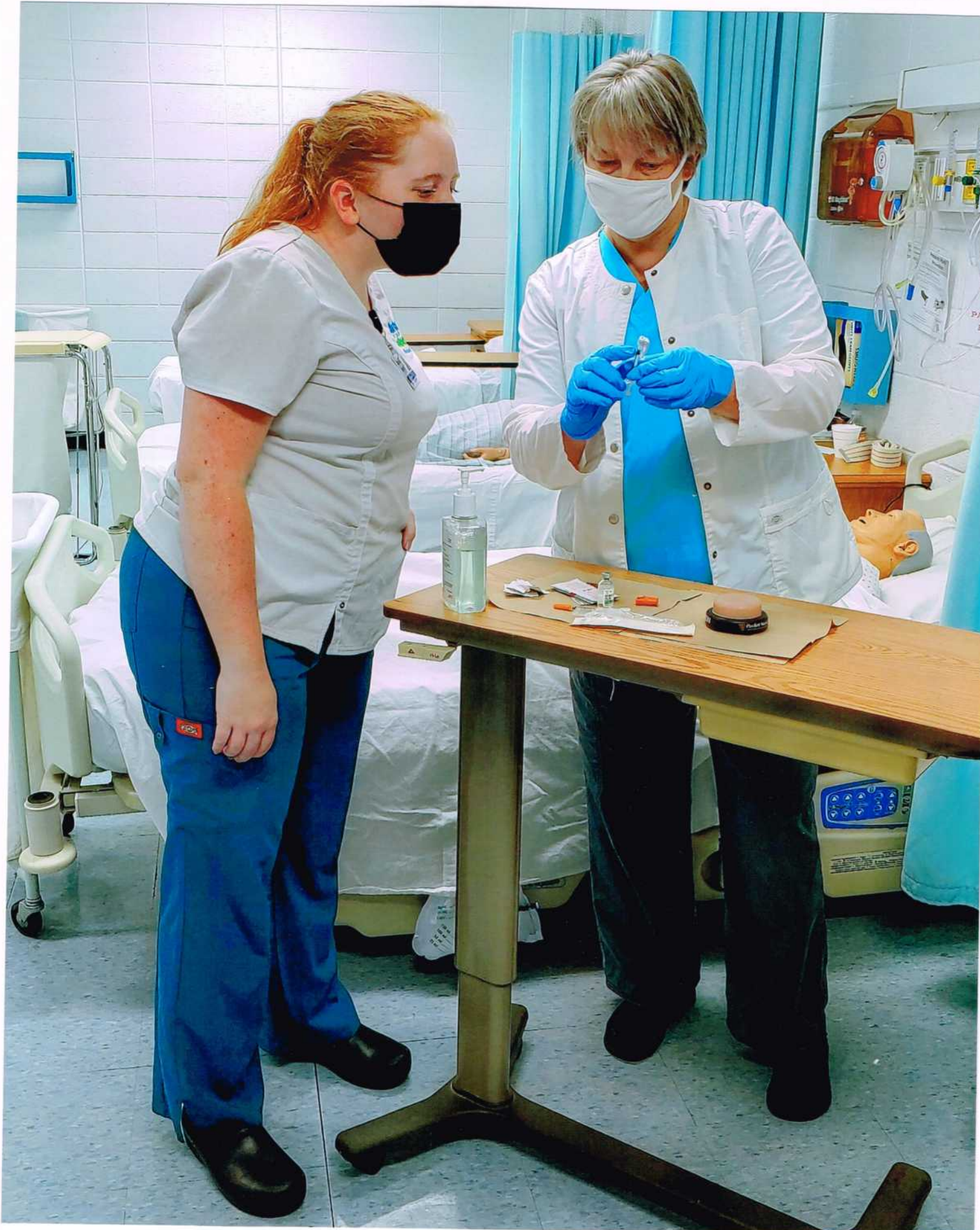

Mrs. Enns has many job responsibilities and hats that she wears daily to develop minds into responsible, caring, knowledgeable, and productive nurses. She teaches students according to the state standards of nursing, while helping students learn through her experiences, as well as always staying informed with up and coming changes and innovations in the nursing field. She is tasked with developing a curriculum for her classes, while also providing live and virtual clinical experiences. She serves as a mentor, motivator, encourager, and critiquer with constructive feedback to help mold her students into amazing nurses and foster their learning in a positive constructive way.

As a nursing instructor the education you need is to be one level higher than what you are teaching. Instructors also need a teaching certificate and be a licensed nurse within the state they are teaching. Being certified in nursing education which requires a master's degree in order to obtain is not required, but is recommended.

Mrs. Enns stated one of the benefits of teaching nursing is the joy she receives from seeing the lights go on in people's understanding, when all the dots are connected and they get it. She has job security and gets to give back by grooming productive members of society and the nursing community.

Some of the challenges of being a nursing instructor are working with students who don't really want to learn; trying to find, have and create effective strategies for teaching unusual topics; and wanting to do more than she has the time to pull together. As well, the pay scale for educators is not the greatest, so loving the job is a must.



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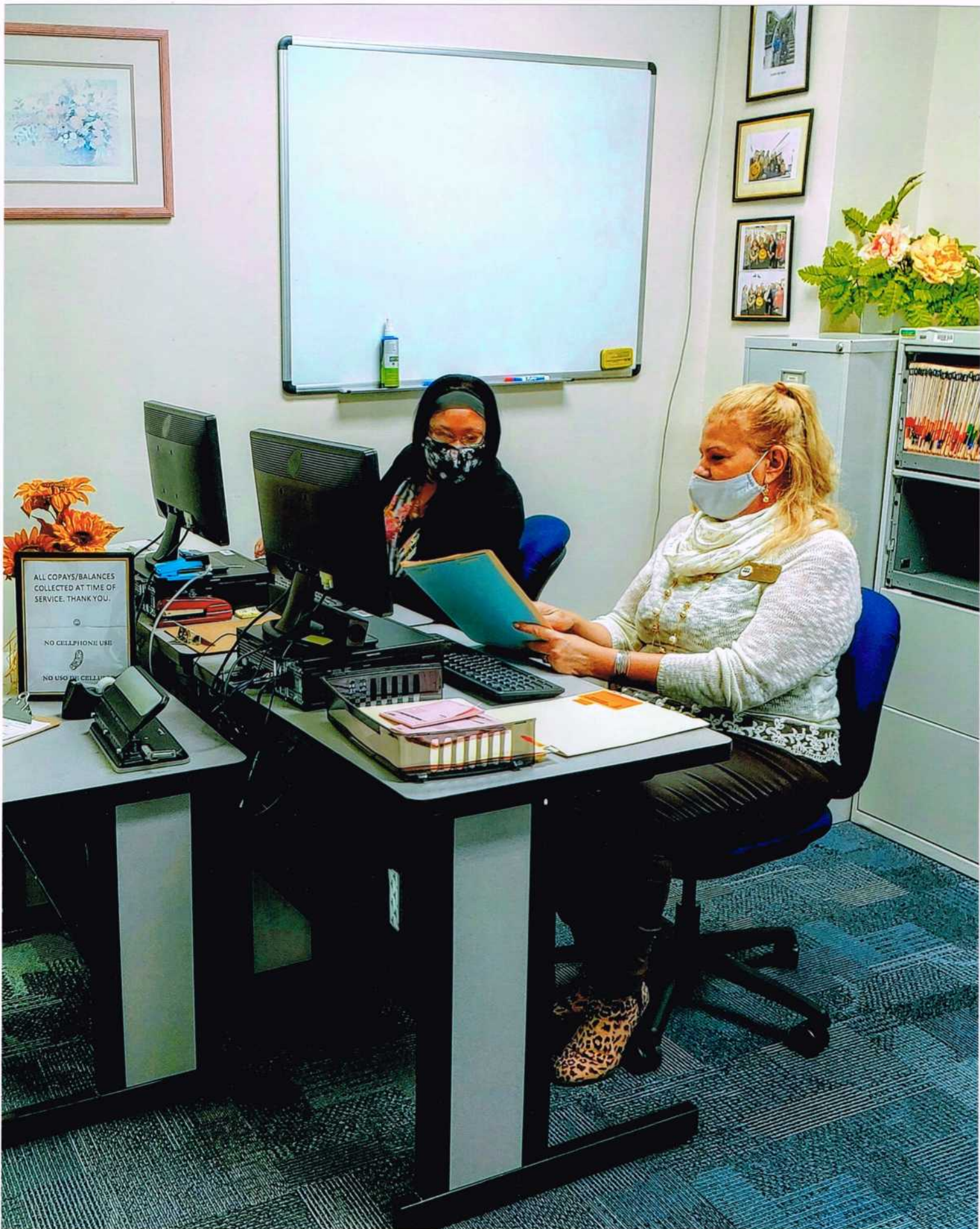

In this picture Ana Lemos CMAA is consulting with Zana Brown on a client's file. As a certified medical administrative assistant she has all the front office tasks to do, answering phones, greeting patients, intake forms, HIPAA compliance forms, data entry, check out duties, scheduling appointments, filing and mail and delivery duties as well being the gatekeeper to the Doctors. Plus she also takes care of billing, coding, and some insurance billing.

The education required to become a certified medical administrative assistant is a ten month program. Most employers also look for you to be trained in Microsoft and Excel, know basic math and have good listening skills.

Benefits to this career are that there is room for career growth, you can start out at the front desk and go to running the office or you can even take these skills and go into teaching others the trade. In this line of work you have job security and in most medical offices you would have a more normal Monday through Friday nine to five kind of schedule. If you decide that the medical field isn't for you, these skills translate into any type of office and you can take them anywhere you go.

One of the major challenges is having to multitask and be detailed without making mistakes, as one wrong number in a date or code can mess everything up and cause more work or major problems for your patient's if not caught. You really need great people skills because as the first face the patients see or talk to on the phone you have to manage people's emotions, resolve complaints and deal with different cultures and language barriers all while staying positive and professional which can be challenging at times.

The education required for this certification is a six week course with a prerequisite of a GED or High School Diploma.

Being a CNA provides you many benefits for example getting to meet and interact with residents from diverse backgrounds, the ability to develop qualities which aid you in providing the best care to your residents, and gaining knowledge of the medical field. It provides hands on experience which allows you the ability to use this career as a stepping stone and work your way up the ladder in the medical field or it can be a lifelong career. You also have job security and the opportunity to have a flexible schedule.

Being a CNA also comes with many challenges for instance language barriers, cultural differences, and having to work with challenging residents and family members. Another challenge related to the residents is trying not to get attached when you spend so much time with them.
