

HOSA Mini Lesson: Handwashing

Objectives:

Upon completion of this lesson, students will have sufficient knowledge of, and be able to:

- 1. identify what the Center for Disease Control and Prevention what you need to know about handwashing.
- 2. list the steps identified by the World Health Organization on how to wash your hands.
- 3. demonstrate appropriate handwashing.
- 4. evaluate the impact of handwashing on patient outcomes.

Time:

- Lecture on handwashing
 ¼ of class period
- Demonstrate of handwashing ½ of class period
- Explore impact of handwashing in health care settings 1/4 of class period.

Instruction:

- 3. Explore the CDC website regarding handwashing & patient safety.
