Consequences of Violating Ethics

Any competitor who violates the ethics rule and code of conduct may forfeit any award won during the conference, as outlined in the General Rules and Regulations of the Competitive Events Program.

- **If the table has a tablecloth, place your Scantron on top of the test booklet before bubbling.**
- You MAY write on the back of the pages and margins of the test booklet as scratch paper.
- Use a #2 pencil (mechanical pencils are discouraged for use on Scantron).
- Fill in the bubble on the Scantron that corresponds with your chosen answer completely. If you skip a question, skip the corresponding number on the Scantron.
- If you have personal needs once you have started the test, please raise your hand.
