Recognition Opportunity for HOSA High School Chapters

Recap:

- The Photo Collection Project is for a High School Member.
- Applicants should review the three categories of photos and how they will secure original or staged photos. The three photo categories that are approved for submission are:
 - **Classroom and Advisor Photos** (4 to 5 photos)
 - **Chapter Community-Based Photos** (4 to 5 photos)
 - **Pre-Career Developmental Photos** (4 to 5 photos)
- Applicants should submit a list of the photos and a rationale for each photo selected or staged. Indicate if the photo is an “Original” or a “Staged” photo. An “Original” photo is taken at a scheduled event/activity. A “Staged” photo is taken at a simulated event/activity. For each photo, identify the Category, Original/Staged, and a Rationale as to “why” the photo was selected.
- There is no limit to the number of High School members who submit a photo collection per chapter from each chartered association.
- Plaques and a cash award will be presented to the top five (5) (overall across all categories) at HOSA's 50th Anniversary Celebration.
- Deadline for submitting **Photo Collection: April 1, 2026 (midnight CST)**.

High School Classroom and Advisor Photos

Periodically, articles are headed to press, and photos of a health science classroom are requested, but we have none or only one. Advisor and classroom photos of value include:

- Chapter Advisor teaching & using media/demonstrating technology tools
- Advisor coaching a HOSA member
- Advisor taking notes while listening to a member making a presentation

- HOSA members engaged in classroom lessons and activities

High School Chapter Community-Based Photos

HOSA High School chapters engage in various community-based activities annually, and HOSA Headquarters has a limited number of photos available upon request for use or sharing. High School Chapter photos of value include:

- Holiday visits to memory care senior living homes
- Engagement with NMDP, state, and local community service projects
- Recreational activities at a local park for foster children
- Halloween party at a children's home.

Pre-Career Developmental Photos

HOSA High School chapters engage in a variety of organizational activities that HOSA Headquarters can discuss, but we are unable to provide visuals of the chapter-based activities. High School photos of value include:

- Election of chapter officers
- Officer candidates campaigning
- Initiation and installation ceremony
- Leadership training program for officers
- Group discussions/panel presentations
- Demonstration using a flipchart/digital technology

The greater the variety of photos, the more impressive the High School collection will be to HOSA-Future Health Professionals. Thank you for seeking a variety of High School photos to demonstrate the value of being engaged in a career-minded High School program that provides a range of early educational experiences to develop the total person in:

- The High School health and biomedical science classroom
- HOSA High School chapter membership and decision-making
- Community-based fundraising projects and service activities
- Leadership development opportunities
- Health industry visitations and tours
- HOSA regional meetings
- HOSA State Leadership Conferences
- HOSA International Leadership Conference, and much more to provide personal, professional, and career-development opportunities

Recognition Process

1. Applicants are requested to submit **10 to 15 High School chapter-focused photographs** by **April 1, 2026 (midnight CST)**. Digital files are required for judging. By submitting photos for this recognition, permission is granted to HOSA to use the High School photos for informational, marketing, and promotional purposes.
2. High School Photos will focus on Classroom and Advisor Photos (4 to 5 photos), Chapter Community-Based Photos (4 to 5 photos), and Pre-Career Developmental Photos (4 to 5 photos).
3. Plaques and a cash award will be presented to the top five (5) (overall across all categories) at HOSA's 50th Anniversary Celebration.
 - a. 1st: \$500
 - b. 2nd: \$200
 - c. 3rd: \$150
 - d. 4th: \$100
 - e. 5th: \$50
