

THE HOSA STORY

Recognition Opportunity for HOSA Chapter Advisors

Recap:

1. This is an opportunity for HOSA **Chapter Advisors** to create a two-minute video to tell how their HOSA journey has resulted in where they are today and what they hope to accomplish in the future.
2. **HOSA Chapter Advisors** are responsible for implementing the HOSA Model that involves recruiting young people who have an interest and potential to be future health professionals. Then, engage HOSA members in the classroom, the member-led chapter (to develop their leadership and soft skills), competitive events aligned with the curriculum, community-based activities that reinforce the importance of teamwork and collaboration, and conferences that emphasize the excitement of demonstrating knowledge and skills and being recognized by their peers.
3. Plaques and a cash award will be presented to the top five (5) (overall across all categories) at HOSA's 50th Anniversary Celebration.
4. The deadline for submitting the 2-minute video is **April 1, 2026 (midnight CST)**.

The Background

The HOSA Story video celebrates the impact of HOSA among **Chapter Advisors**, highlighting how classroom learning and chapter experiences combine to develop the technical, leadership, and professional skills essential for success in the health professions. Through a short, inspiring video, participants can share their personal HOSA journey and showcase how HOSA truly prepares future health professionals to lead, learn, serve, innovate, and succeed.

Eligibility

- **HOSA Chapter Advisors** may participate by creating a **2-minute informational and inspiring** video using the prompt below:
- **HOSA Chapter Advisor:** Create a video that illustrates how the combination of classroom teaching (health and biomedical science) and chapter advising (HOSA) provides you with the opportunities, best practices, and experiences to help your student members develop technical, leadership, and professional skills to become future health professionals. Provide examples of the health professions that your graduates have pursued.

Tips for Video Production:

- **Create a storyboard.** Draw what scenes you would like to capture in your video. Plan your project before you start shooting.
- **Clear sound is essential.** Make sure that you are in a quiet environment when you start recording your HOSA Story. The audio must be clear and at a normal volume.

- **Check the lighting.** Good lighting is vital. When shooting outside, it is best to record on a day when the sun is bright and everything is clearly visible. When inside, make certain there is proper lighting.

Recognition Process

1. **Chapter Advisors** create a 2-minute video.
2. The submission deadline is **April 1, 2026 (midnight CST)**.
